



INTERNATIONAL APPLICANTS - There is no application fee, and the deposit fee is waived. The preferred international application deadline for the fall semester is March 15th, however, the international admissions office will work with later applicants as well.

APPLICATION MATERIALS

Official, verified copies of test scores, transcripts, and English proficiency results must be sent by the test center to dswanso@olivet.edu. Olivet Nazarene University does not accept these materials directly from students as official. All student submission materials are considered unofficial.

Students interested in admission to Olivet Nazarene University must submit:

- Olivet Nazarene University online Application www.olivet.edu/apply
- Official copies of your **academic records from all secondary schools** and colleges in which you are currently enrolled or have previously attended. Transcripts should include the most recent 3 years of grades. Academic records need to be sent to ECE or WES for an official evaluation. Athletes send to Incred for evaluation.
- **English Proficiency Exam** IELTS, TOEFL. Minimum test scores are required for admission: IELTS 6.5 band score, TOEFL score of 70
- **Proof of Finances**. Submit a Bank Statement signed by a bank official showing one year's tuition/fees, along with an affidavit of support signed and notarized.
- **Photocopy of your valid passport** in .jpg or .pdf format should be emailed to: dswanso2@olivet.edu International Student Services.
- **Statement of personal faith**- a paragraph sharing your religious belief and how Olivet fits into your plans
- **Standardized Test Scores**. Submit ONE of the following: **SAT or ACT score reports**. We do not require these tests, but they help with course placement.
- **Two Letters of Recommendation** – from teacher, counselor, coach, employer, or clergy who can attest to your character.

Official copies of test score reports should be sent directly to Olivet Nazarene University by the respective testing agencies. However, if a copy is mailed or emailed, it must be certified by a school official as an official copy of the original.

- **English Proficiency**- a copy of previous language exam sent to current school, or two semesters of English Composition I & II with a grade of C- or better
- **Proof of Finances**. Submit a Bank Statement signed by a bank official showing one year's tuition/fees, along with an affidavit of support signed and notarized.
- **Photocopy of your valid passport** in .jpg or .pdf format should be emailed to: dswanso2@olivet.edu International Student Services.
- **Visa**- submit copy or current visa
- **I-20** – submit a current copy of valid I-20
- **Statement of personal faith**- a paragraph sharing your religious belief and how Olivet fits into your plans
- **One Letter of Recommendation** – from teacher, counselor, coach, employer, or clergy who can attest to your character.
